HISTORY OF THE HONORARY DOCTORATE

An honorary doctorate is a prestigious award that recognizes individuals for their exceptional contributions to society, specific fields, and the world at large. The tradition of awarding honorary degrees dates back to the Middle Ages when universities, for various reasons, would grant exemptions from some or all of the standard requirements for awarding a degree. The earliest recorded honorary degree was conferred upon Lionel Woodville in the late 1470s by the University of Oxford. Woodville later became the Bishop of Salisbury.

In the United States, the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) degree was first awarded as an honorary degree at Bucknell University in 1852. It wasn't until 1861 that any American university conferred an earned Ph.D., with Yale University being the first to do so. By the end of the 19th century, over one hundred institutions in the United States had awarded honorary Ph.D. degrees to more than seven hundred individuals.

WHAT IS AN HONORARY DOCTORATE?

An honorary doctorate, or Doctor Honoris Causa, is a doctoral-level honor awarded by a university or institution to an individual who has made significant contributions to society or specific fields. Honorary doctorates are typically conferred upon individuals who have made profound impacts in areas such as healthcare, economics, entertainment, politics, business, medicine, science, and the arts. Recipients often include presidents, world leaders, celebrities, scientists, artists, healers, astrologers, coaches, and legal professionals, all of whom have made notable contributions to society.

It is important to note that honorary doctorates are not equivalent to earned Ph.D. degrees. They do not permit recipients to practice as doctors in the professional sense. When used, the title is typically written as Dr. Daniel, Ph.D. (hc) or Dr. (hc) Samson, where "hc" stands for Honoris Causa, meaning "for the sake of honor."

An honorary doctorate is an academic degree awarded to individuals without the need to complete a formal course of study. It serves as an acknowledgment of exceptional achievement in fields such as science, literature, politics, and other disciplines.

OBTAINING AN HONORARY DOCTORATE

Honorary doctorates are usually awarded by universities to individuals who have made significant contributions to their respective fields. Here are some steps that can help you in getting an honorary doctorate.

Identify the university or institution where you want to receive the honorary doctorate: You can choose a university or institution that is related to your field of work or one that has a good reputation for awarding honorary doctorates.

Contact the university or institution: You can send a letter or email to the university or institution explaining your achievements and contributions to your field, and your interest in receiving an honorary doctorate. It is important to provide evidence of your contributions, such as publications, awards, and recognitions.

Get nominated: In most cases, you need to be nominated by a member of the university's academic community, such as a professor, dean, or chancellor. You can reach out to individuals who you have worked with or who have knowledge of your work to request a nomination.

Review: The nomination is typically reviewed by a committee, which may be comprised of faculty, administration, and/or members of the university's governing board. The committee will consider the individual's qualifications, achievements, and contributions, and will make a recommendation to the university's governing board.

Approval: If the governing board approves the recommendation, the individual will be invited to receive the honorary doctorate at a formal ceremony. The ceremony may include a speech by the honor, as well as the conferring of the degree and other honors.

HONORARY AWARDS POLICY STATEMENT

1. Purpose:

Honorary Awards are conferred by the University to:

- a. Formally and publicly recognize the exceptional or distinguished contributions of an individual to the university, broader society, or a specific field of academic endeavor.
- b. Enhance the standing and reputation of the University.
- c. Expand and strengthen existing relationships.

2. Prestige:

Honorary Awards are prestigious distinctions, intended to recognize substantial achievements or contributions by individuals in various fields.

3. Approval Process:

Honorary Awards are granted by the University Council following a comprehensive selection process. This process includes the application of defined criteria and thorough due diligence procedures, including risk assessments, to ensure the protection of both the recipient and the University.

4. Criteria for Awarding:

To maintain the honor and prestige of these awards, honorary degrees will only be conferred upon individuals of suitable stature. Therefore, the Council is under no obligation to award an honorary degree in any given year.

5. Revocation: To preserve the integrity of the awards and safeguard the University's reputation, the Council may, at its discretion, revoke an Honorary Award if it believes the recipient's continued association with the University could tarnish the institution's standing.

6. Confidentiality: All nominations must be handled with the utmost confidentiality. Nominees must not be informed of or consulted about their nomination at any stage of the process.

PRINCIPLES & CRITERIA FOR CANDIDATE SELECTION

Statutory Authority:

Abraham Lincoln University (ALU) is vested with the authority to grant honorary degrees. The University Senate is responsible for awarding these degrees, while Convocation has the authority to confer the honorary degrees approved by the Senate. The Senate's bylaws establish an Honorary Degrees Committee tasked with recommending nominees for honorary degrees, which are then submitted for Senate consideration. Honorary degrees may be conferred at any Convocation, provided the names of the nominees have been reviewed, approved by the Honorary Degrees Committee, and recommended by the Senate.

Statement of Purpose:

An honorary degree is the highest honor the University can bestow. The acceptance of such a degree honors both the recipient and the University. Typically, one honorary doctorate is conferred at each Convocation ceremony. Honorary degrees are awarded to individuals who have made unique and exceptional contributions to their respective fields.

Criteria for Selection:

Honorary degrees are awarded to individuals who have achieved outstanding accomplishments in research, scholarly and artistic works, public service, professional or philanthropic activities, or athletic excellence. The Honorary Degrees Committee considers the following factors when selecting candidates:

1. The level of excellence and eminence demonstrated by the candidate in scholarship, scientific inquiry, or artistic endeavors, with recognition on a national or international scale.
2. The extraordinary nature of the candidate's public service to humankind.
3. The candidate's significant creative, material, or financial contributions that have greatly benefited the University.
4. The candidate's athletic achievements and prowess.
5. The potential of the candidate to inspire graduating students at Convocation.
6. A commitment to ensuring a balance across academic disciplines, professional contributions, and diversity in gender and cultural backgrounds.
7. The committee may also take into consideration individuals who have been historically overlooked due to social prejudice or ignorance.

EXCLUSIONS :

The following individuals are generally not eligible for consideration for an honorary degree:

1. Current members of the University's Board or Senate.
2. Current or recently retired members of the University's faculty or staff, as well as current students.
3. Current holders of elected office at any level (municipal, provincial, federal, or members of the Senate).

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

1. Elected officials may be considered only if they do not exert political influence over the University or its electorate.
2. Former holders of elected office or former federal Senators are eligible for consideration.
3. Religious leaders may be considered only if their contributions extend beyond their religious leadership.

PROCEDURE FOR NOMINATIONS :

1. Any member of the University community or the public may submit a nomination, signed by at least three nominators. Nominators must declare their knowledge of the nominee's achievements and must not be related to the nominee.
2. Nominations should be addressed to the Senate Honorary Degrees Committee.
3. If a committee member has a personal or business connection with a nominee, they must disclose it to the committee. Such individuals may recuse themselves from discussion or voting based on the nature of the conflict.
4. Nominations from committee members are allowed, but they must declare a conflict of interest and refrain from voting on the matter.

DECISIONS :

The Honorary Degrees Committee will only consider complete nominations. The committee may:

1. Recommend the nominee for Senate approval for one of the honorary degrees listed in the bylaws.
2. Request additional information from nominators or others for future consideration.
3. Reject the nomination.
4. The Senate will receive and vote on each nomination separately at its next meeting. In special cases, such as during a special Convocation, the Honorary Degrees Committee may submit its recommendation to the Executive Committee, which is authorized to approve candidates for honorary degrees in exceptional circumstances.

PUBLICIZING THE NOMINATION AND AWARD:

Nominators should not inform nominees that they are being considered for an honorary degree. The University will not release individual nomination outcomes until a public announcement is made regarding the honorary degree recipients for a particular Convocation.

AWARDING :

Honorary degree recipients are invited to deliver the onvocation address, though they may decline the invitation. Honorary degrees are not awarded posthumously, except when the award has been accepted and arrangements have been made prior to the nominee's passing. The citation for the honorary degree should not exceed three minutes in length.

REVOCAATION :

The Senate holds the authority to revoke an honorary degree and all associated privileges. Revocation is subject to a vote by the Senate, based on a recommendation from the Honorary Degrees Committee.

5. The honorary doctorate has lifetime validity.

4. Maintaining Prestige:

To uphold their prestige, honorary awards are only granted to individuals of appropriate standing. There is no obligation for the University Council to make an award in any category each year.

5. Revocation of Awards:

The University reserves the right to revoke an honorary award if the recipient's association with the University poses a risk of disrepute.

6. Confidentiality of Nominations:

All nominations are treated with strict confidentiality. Nominees must not be informed or consulted about their nomination at any stage of the process.
